### ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have ordered to create Soft Skill Centres in the first phase in 30 colleges for empowering students to face, stress, demands, challenges and gain employability. Accordingly, a sum of Rs.135 lakh have been sanctioned as follows:-

1. Rs.60.00 lakh [@ Rs.2 lakh per institution] for non-recurring as seed money for the purchase of Copier, public Address System, Stationery etc.
2. Rs.75.00 lakh [@ Rs.2.50 lakh per institution] towards recurring expenditure for skill training.

2. In the letter fourth read above, the Member-Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education has stated that the above scheme in the first phase was well received by the students and created new awareness about the Soft Skills. Considering the success implementation and the appreciation received from the student community, this Centres may be extended to another 32 colleges.

3. The Member-Secretary, Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education has also requested the Government to permit administrative and financial sanction (Rs.64 lakh for non-recurring and Rs.80 lakh for recurring) towards creating Soft Skill Centres in the above 32 Colleges in the second phase.

4. The Government after careful consideration, accord sanction for establishing Soft Skill Centre in the second phase to the 32 Government Arts and Science Colleges as shown in the Annexure to this order.

5. Further the Government sanction a sum of Rs.1.44 crore (Rupees one crore and forty four lakh only) i.e., Rs.64.00 lakh [@ Rs.2 lakh per institution] as seed money for the purchase of Copier, public Address System, Stationery etc. as non recurring expenditure and Rs.80.00 lakh [@ Rs.2.50 lakh per institution] towards recurring expenditure for skill training.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited under the following Head of account :-

"2202 General Education - 03 University and Higher Education -104 Assistance to Non-Government Colleges and Institutes - I. Non-Plan - AC Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education - 09 Grants -in-Aid - 03 Grants for Specific Schemes (DPC 2202 03.104 AC 0934)".

7. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RBE/RE/FMA 2016-17. Pending provision of such funds in RBE/BE/FMA 2016-17, the Director of Collegiate Education is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. This expenditure should be brought to the notice of the Legislature, by specific inclusion in the RBE/ Supplementary Estimates 2016-17. The Director of Collegiate Education is directed to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget proposal for RE/FMA 2016-17 and also to send necessary Explanatory Notes for including the above expenditure in the RBE / Supplementary Estimate 2016-17 to Finance (Edn-I/BG-I) Department without fail.

8. The Director of Collegiate Education shall draw and disburse the amount to the Member-Secretary (i/c), Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education, Chennai.

9. The Member-Secretary (i/c), Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education, Chennai is requested to send the Utilisation Certificate to the Director of Collegiate Education, Chennai and to Government in due course.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.23381/Edn-I/2016, dated 22.04.2016 and ASL No.100 [One Hundred].
